Becoming a Tri-Share Child Care Provider

Good News: Employers in your area and the State of North Carolina have combined forces to create an additional subsidy program which may benefit your child care facility. The children in your program may qualify if their parent works for one of the designated employers, and their families fit within certain income categories. This subsidy is available to a whole group of families who have not previously qualified for child care subsidy.

Partners for Children & Families of Moore County is implementing Tri-Share in Moore, Chatham, Cumberland, Hoke, Montgomery, Richmond, Scotland, and Union Counties.

Through this innovative new approach, child care expenses are shared by the employer, the employee, and the State to assist qualifying employees with child care costs.

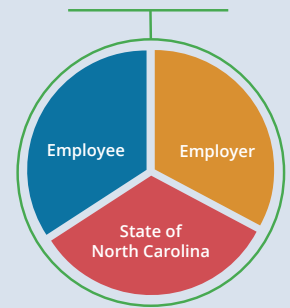

Household Size	Yearly Income (185%-300% of federal poverty level)
Two Person	\$36,482- \$59,160
Three Person	\$45,991-\$74,580
Four Person	\$55,500-\$90,000
Five Person	\$65,009-\$105,420
Six Person	\$74,518- \$120,840
Seven Person	\$84,027- \$136,260
Eight Person	\$93,536- \$151,680
