Early Care and Education Subsidy

1. Child Care Subsidy: Income-based child care assistance.
2. NC Pre-K: Supplemental assistance for "at-risk" four-year-old children in state-approved preschool classrooms.
3. WAGE\$: Financial supplements to teachers, directors and family child care home providers in Moore County.

Early Care and Education Quality

1. Child Care Resource: Training and technical assistance to child care providers.
2. Subsidy Administration: Case management of child care assistance program.
3. Child Care Health Consultant: Technical assistance for child care facilities regarding health and safety issues.

Early Literacy

1. Reach Out and Read: Family literacy promotion and book distribution to children by doctors.
2. Encouraging Early Literacy: Family literacy promotion and book distribution to children by child development service providers.
3. Raising A Reader: Family literacy promotion and book distribution to children by early educators.
4. Motherread: Adult and child literacy instruction according to a nationally recognized model where parents will improve their own reading skills; learn how to help their children become better readers and thinkers; and develop better family communication skills.
5. Dolly Parton's Imagination Library: A literacy program where all Moore County children can receive a book in the mail every month until their 5th birthday.

Family Support

1. Positive Parenting Program (Triple P): Parent education program that aims to prevent child maltreatment and strengthen parenting confidence.

Program Support

1. Program Management: Service delivery coordination and monitoring.
2. Community Education & Engagement: Public outreach and community leadership services.
